- The survey was conducted by using vmedulife Application, from vmedulife software services, Pune
- Around 90% students from B. Pharm. and M. Pharm. courses actively participated in survey.
- Results were analysed through vmedulife Application and Analysis report was generated as Follows.

Student Satisfaction Survey Report

1. Overall content and Design of curriculum
Response- About 80.95% students were satisfied with design of curriculum
2. Role of curriculum for overall personality development
Response-About 77.5% students agree that design of curriculum is responsible for overall personality development
3. Conduct of regular theory and practical classes as per curriculum
Response- 90 % students are satisfied regarding conduct of regular theory and practical classes
4. Availability of infrastructural facilities in college
Response-More than 90% of students of B.Pharm and M.Pharm course are satisfied with Availability of infrastructural facilities in college
5. Relevance of contents of curriculum to industry requirements
Response-About 80 to 85 % of students agree that content of syllabus is relevant, updated and satisfy the needs of the industry.
6. Academic Discipline(timely conduct of lectures, practicals and related activities
Response- All the academic activities are performed through various internal committees like Academic planning and monitoring committee, Exam committee, Greavience redressal committee etc. So More than 95% of students are satisfied with respect to Academic disipline
7. Satisfaction with the overall facilities available as per curriculum

Response-Various internal committees exist in the college like Purchase committee, Library committee, Grievance redressal committee etc. These committees work in co-ordination to provide all the necessary facilities to students.

8. The college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications:
Response- About 90 % of teachers are satisfied for providing adequate opportunities and support for upgradation of skill.
9. The books/journals etc. prescribed / listed as reference materials are relevant, updated and cover the entire syllabi
Response- More than 95% of students are satisfied regarding availability of books/ journals/ and other reference materials in the library.
10. Illustration of the concepts through examples and application
Response- 85 to 90% students agree that the subject teacher explain the concept through examples and applications.
11. Identification of individuals' weaknesses and help to overcome them
Response- College has appointed guardian teachers for every 15-20 students. These teachers help students under their guardianship in all respect . Most of the students agree this
12. Percentage of teachers use ICT tools
Response-About 80- 90% of teachers use ICT tools for effective teaching learning.
13. Facilitation for preparation of entrance examination for pursuing higher studies
Response- Faculty members provide additional coaching for preparation of GPAT exam for higher studies.
14. Overall quality of teaching-learning process
Response- 90% of students of B.pharm and M.pharm course are satisfied about overall quality of teaching – learning process.
15. Organization of workshop/ seminars/ guest lecture for students
Response- 85 to 90% of students are satisfied regarding organization of workshop/ seminars/ guest lecture for students and teachers.
