#### **Genesis of the Conference**

The field of Genomics & Pharmacogenomics is growing rapidly and its development is making tremendous impacts in medical sciences and pharmaceuticals. Pharmacogenomics uses information about a person's genetic makeup, or genome, to choose the drugs and drug doses that are likely to work best for that particular person. Genomic research has changed that "one size fits all" approach and opened the door to more personalized approaches to using and developing drugs. This new field combines the science of how drugs work, called pharmacology, with the science of the human genome, called genomics. It has made huge advancements over the course of time and is continuing to influence various sectors.

Pharmacogenomics is the tailoring of drug treatments to people's genetic makeup, a form of 'personalised medicine'. This conference aimed to upgrade professionals engaged in pre-clinical & clinical aspects of drugs with changed perspectives and to provide an opportunity to upgrade their knowledge of drug and thereby help them go a long way in drug research using genomic &pharmacogenomic approaches.

-how genomic information can be used to develop more personalized and costeffective strategies for using drugs to improve human health.

#### **REPORT**

On 03<sup>rd</sup> Aug 19, Conference was begun with the Inauguration of Registration Counter at 9.00 am. Delegates reached to venue from different parts of country. College has provided the taxi facility to Pickup & Drop for delegates coming from out station. They completed their Registration at Registration Counters. They were welcomed by giving a rose flower & handed over their Kit by Registration Committee. After that registered delegates enjoyed their yummy breakfast & tea from 9.00 am.

Conference was inaugurated on 03rd Aug 19 at 10.30 am. During inauguration, Hon'ble Shri Nilayji Naik, Member of Legislative Council, Maharashtra State; Shri Jagdish G. Wadhwani, President, Yavatmal Zilla Vikas Samiti; Guest of Honor Dr. K. Satyamoorthy, Professor & Director, School of Life Sciences, Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal; Dr. Ritushree Kukreti, Senior Principal Scientist, Institute of Genomics & Integrative Biology, CSIR, New Delhi; Dr. Anil Chandewar, Principal, P.Wadhwani College of Pharmacy, & Convener of conference were present on the dais. Delegates came from different states of India witnessed the inauguration function. Hon'ble Shri Nilayji Naik, Member of Legislative Council, Maharashtra State inaugurated the conference by cutting the ribbon. Inauguration was followed by Sarswati Poojan & floral warm welcome of guests by Members of Organizing Committee. Conference Souvenir was published at the hands of respected Hon'ble members present on the dais. Dr. Nitin Kochar, Co-convener of conference welcomed the guests & delegates came for conference. He highlighted on the theme of conference. During his speech he spoke about the genesis of conference, worldwide present status of research on genomics & pharmacogenomics, & about the number of delegates came for poster presentation & attending the conference. About 142 candidates registered as Delegate, out of which 45 delegates participated in Poster Presentation Competition. Dr. Anil Chandewar during his Introductory speech, explained the importance of Pharmacogenomics in individual life. He further added individual patient responds differently for the same drug. Hence, treatment should be more focused individually considering his genome &

physiology so that toxicity & adverse effects of drug treatment can be minimized. Hon'ble **Shri Nilayji Naik** in his speech shared his experiences related to drug treatment. He told that every individual has a specific genome structure which are hereditary. Doctor prescribes drug on the basis of symptoms & age of the patient. But, it should be based upon the individual genetic makeup & sensitivity. He further demanded the need of individual patient treatment based on his genome study.

Inaugural program was conducted by Dr. Shilpa Gawande & Vote of Thanks was extended by Dr. Abhijit Shrirao.

It was immediately followed by the First Session of **Dr. Ritushree Kukreti** at 11.30 am. Chairperson for this session was **Dr. Pranita Kashyap**, Principal, Dr. R.G. Bhoyar Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research, Wardha. Dr. Kashyap has introduced Dr. Kukreti by reading his short bio-data. Then she requested Dr. Kukreti to deliver her presentation. Dr. Kukreti delivered her research work entitled **"Pharmacogenomic signatures for variable drug response in patients with epilepsy: Implications for therapy and disease management"**. In her presentation, she talked about whole-genome expression study, taking epilepsy as the disease-ofinterest. At the end of her presentation, queries were raised which were answered nicely by Dr. Kukreti. After this, Dr. Kashyap felicited Dr. Kukreti by giving her a Memento. Memento of Chairperson was given to Dr. Kashyap by Dr. Anil Chandewar.

First Session was immediately followed by Second Session of Dr. K. Satyamoorthy at 12.30 pm. For this session, Chairperson was Dr. Shirish Jain, Principal, Rajarshri Shahu College of Pharmacy, Buldana. Dr. Jain introduced Dr. K. Satyamoorthy. It was then followed by presentation of Dr. K. Satyamoorthy. He has given his on his research entitled "Relevance and Application of presentation Pharmacoepigenomics for Personalized Medicine". He expressed Pharmacogenomics as a key component to develop, improve and provide chemotherapeutic agents to treat number of human diseases. He also told about simultaneously new molecular targets are identified and drugs being designed to treat individuals based on advanced knowledge from whole genome analysis. He has shown his study on not only the SNPs and CpGs but also miSNPs that determine the status of CYP2C19 and hence the effect on the drug clopidogrel. These and other results were highlighted. At last, he also replied various queries raised by delegates. At the end, he was felicited by Dr. Shirish Jain by giving Memento. Dr. Jain was felicited by giving Chairperson Memento at the hands of Dr. Anil Chandewar.

This session was followed by a break for delicious Lunch at 2.00 pm.

Poster Presentation was started after Lunch at 2.30 pm at Poster Presentation Hall. About 45 posters were displayed. They were evaluated by Dr. K. Satyamoorthy & Dr. Kukreti. They identified Best Poster award for Miss R. N. Agrawal, Runner was Mr. S. N. Ande. Winners of Poster presentation were felicited by giving Memento to them. Two consolation certificates were given to S.R. Ganorkar & Ms. Dipali Shegar.

Resource person for Third session was Dr. Pronobesh Chattopadhyay. But due to some urgent health problems, he expressed his inability to come for conference on dated 01/08/19. After completion of his presentation, various queries raised by delegates were satisfied by Dr. Rathore. . At the end, he was felicited by Dr. Indurwade by giving Memento. 
